

ONE-ON-ONE AIDE/ PARAPROFESSIONAL

Special education paraprofessionals and one on one aides, under the direct supervision of special education teachers and administration, will support and assist students within the classroom or other educational settings so that all support needs of students are met. Specific roles/duties are determined by the level of student needs and staffing of the classroom.

DUTIES

- Support the student directly in his academic, social, emotional, self-help, and health development and goals
- Support the student directly in staying safe and engaged in the classroom
- Support special education and general education teachers in their academic, social, emotional, self-help, and health development of students with disabilities.
- Support the implementation and progress monitoring of Individualized Education Plans.
- Provide individual support to the student both within and outside of the general setting to provide access to general activities to the maximum extent possible.
- Assist both special education as well as general education teachers with maintaining student IEP records.
- Work within a team of other professionals such as speech therapist, counselor, occupational therapist, etc.
